Project Goal: the goal is simple!

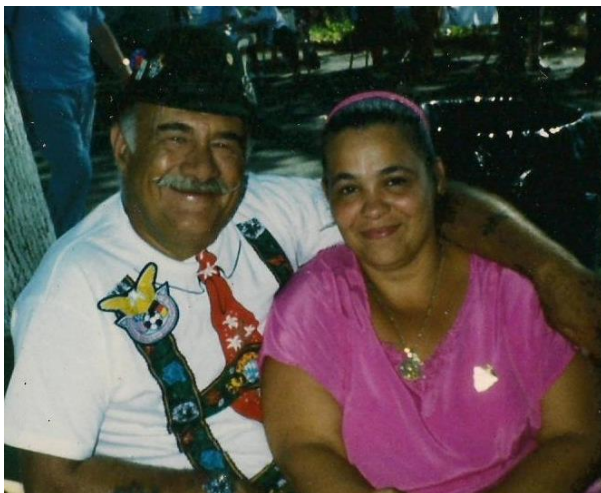
- Help Raise \$60,000 to help bridge the funding the gap needed to build a new home

Background Information

The Henn family is a low-moderate income family who lost their home as a result of hurricane Sandy. The family consists of a widowed grandmother raising her 18 year old granddaughter Katari, who has already suffered the tragedy of losing her mother when she was a little girl. Katari is a recent graduate of Middletown High School North.

As a result of the damage caused by hurricane Sandy their house is deemed unsafe and unlivable. The family now lives in a one room bedroom apartment in Keansburg NJ and has been displaced for almost two years because they simply do not have enough money to re-build their home.
